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# Information Systems Use Policy

- The use of Information Systems, personal or college (*computers, laptops, networking equipment, network resources, servers, smart phones, tablets, telephones, etc.*) on either the college's private or public networks requires the acceptance of the North Central Kansas Technical College's Information Systems Use Policy. End users (*you*) are independently and solely responsible for complying with all applicable laws and policies in all of your actions related to your use of personal or college information systems on any college networks, regardless of the purpose of the use.

# College Networks

- **Wired Networks** – private networks that supports all college computers, telephones and building climate control.
- **Wireless Networks** – There are three main wireless networks at NCK Tech  
(*2 public networks and 1 private network*) throughout the college.

- **Campus** – a public use network that requires a key\* to join and is available to any NCK Tech student, faculty, staff member or guest with a personal computer (*laptops, netbooks, tablets, smart phones, etc.*)
- **Campus Guests** – An open, unsecured public wireless network available (*Monday – Friday; 8am to 5pm*).

\* **Campus** wireless network key is posted on our [Intranet](#)



# Dorm Networks

- For students living in the dorms (*Beloit campus only*); a secured 802.11a/n wireless Internet connection is available for desktops, laptops, and gaming consoles; (Xbox, Wii and Play Stations).

**In order for the Internet at the dorms to function properly and at it's best, the following rules MUST be followed:**

- Each resident is **allowed up to 3 devices** to connect to their Dorms wireless network.  
**Examples:** 1-Laptop, 1-Tablet, 1-Gaming Console, or a Smartphone.
- **No wireless routers** are allowed in the dorms.
- **No wireless access points or repeaters** are allowed in the dorms.
- **Smartphone Hotspots** are discouraged throughout the college in order to reduce unnecessary and potentially disruptive wireless signals and interference.
- All dorm residents are **encouraged NOT to share** their unique dorms wireless network key.
- All dorm residents are **required to read, understand and follow** NCK Tech's [Dorms Acceptable Use Policy](#).

# Website Content Filtering

- NCK Tech uses “**content filtering**” to make sure our employees, students and guests do not view sites that contain or display objectionable material. Filtering can only be accomplished at an “**all or nothing**” level. We cannot turn on a site for only one person and no one else. Please understand that these filtering protocols apply to everyone (*guests, students and employees’ alike*) using any of the college’s networks public or private to access the Internet.
  - Faculty and staff - if you are experiencing difficulty viewing certain websites, or have discovered an objectionable website and would like to see it blocked; please contact NCK Tech’s IT staff for assistance or use our online [website filtering request form](#)

# NCK Tech o365

- NCK Tech now uses Microsoft 365 for our employees and students
  - NCK Tech employees have email accounts that use their first initial lastname@ncktc.edu
  - Every on-campus NCK Tech student now also has a Microsoft account. Their account is the same username as their CAMS account, camsusername@ncktc.edu
    - Email attachment size limitation (25MB)
    - Email white list and black listing options available
    - NCK Tech Email signature files available, contact NCK Tech IT staff
    - Maximum Mailbox size is 25GB

# Email SPAM Filtering

- NCK Tech uses Microsoft 365 with Anti-SPAM settings to reduce junk email to our end users
  - When a new college email user receives their first SPAM message, Microsoft SPAM will automatically place that message in their SPAM Folder. So check your SPAM folder often.
  - For any messages that are not SPAM, the end user may mark that message as NOT SPAM and Microsoft will remember the changes.

# Data File Storage

- NCK Tech provides on-campus data replication file storage to our full-time faculty and staff
  - File servers are available to any full-time faculty or staff who wish to securely replicate their college data for disaster recovery
- NCK Tech Domain controllers are for on-campus student logins and on-campus student file storage
  - NCK Tech Domain controllers provide on-campus student logins and file storage for all currently enrolled students

# Document Center

- NCK Tech provides a college Intranet Document Center for our employees and students convenience
  - All student documents are available to any user
  - Faculty documents can be accessed by providing your NCK Tech's personal username and password when prompted
    - Right click and select "Save As" to download the document to your PC
    - Faculty Handbook
    - Student Handbook
    - Professional Development Plan
    - Online Course Development Procedures
    - Employee and Student Timesheets
    - Payroll Documents
    - Travel Reimbursement Documents, etc.

# NCK Tech Telephones

- NCK Tech's – Cisco IP Telephones
  - All telephones and telephone services (*voicemail, analog lines, fax machines, phone numbers and extensions*) are managed by the college's IT Department

# CAMS Portals

- NCK Tech uses CAMS for our student records software. CAMS provides a web portal for faculty and students to access their classes, grades, billing and other information.
